



Jérémie Vosse at the service of footballers in lockdown with his luxury concierge service



SPORTS SCAN - In the midst of the coronavirus epidemic, Jérémie Vosse, founder of Premium Conciergerie, continues to meet the demands of some footballers and other clients to facilitate their confinement.

"We facilitate life and fulfill desires," is how Jérémie Vosse describes his company, **Premium Conciergerie**. The members of this luxury concierge service are largely footballers playing for top European clubs, but also include public figures and business leaders. "Our job is to do everything, or try to do everything, to make things easier for them," explains the company head.



In normal times, Premium Concierge teams are called upon by their clients to book private jets and villas for holidays, a pet, a star chef who can come and prepare a meal at home, a housekeeper, a babysitter... But with the coronavirus epidemic raging all over the world and the lockdown in force, the company has had to reinvent itself to satisfy new demands.

At the beginning of the health crisis, several athlete members panicked, as Jérémie Vosse explains: "Some asked to leave quickly to spend their lockdown elsewhere, and others who play abroad wanted to return to France." And when the lockdown was implemented, the requests evolved: grocery shopping, finding gloves, hand sanitizer, masks, doctors... But there are more complicated periods, especially when a player's family or loved ones are affected by Covid-19. "Supporting and helping our members through these difficult times is part of our job. We are very present and very close to our clients," says the founder of the company based on Place Vendôme in Paris. "We feel very useful and very appreciated during this time. (Our clients) are very grateful for what we do, and that warms my heart," admits Jérémie Vosse.

Even though the leagues are suspended due to the coronavirus pandemic, footballers must continue training from home. Due to confidentiality requirements, the entrepreneur doesn't disclose the names of his clients, but his address book is full of football stars "who play for the biggest European clubs as well as the French national team." As a result, the luxury concierge service has received numerous requests for sports equipment. A real challenge during the lockdown: "It was very complex to manage; we understand how vital it is for them, but we went to great lengths to find solutions and ship them what they needed."

A significant loss of revenue

For the founder of Premium Conciergerie, the economic impact of the health crisis is significant. "We're right in the eye of the storm. The first

sectors hit by this crisis were event organizers and the travel industry, and we operate in both sectors, so we've been hit twice," says Jérémie Vosse.

But the business owner isn't giving up and remains hopeful:

"There will be better days! We don't have a choice anyway. We're healthy, that's the main thing. We're going back to basics, and we'll deal with the material side of things later."


